






Monday, September 29 and Friday, October 10 **The Amalfi Coast**



Today we tour the beautiful **Amalfi Coast** with a stop and tour of **Positano**, a stop and tour with lunch in **Amalfi**, and a scenic stop in **Ravello** before we return to the hotel for dinner.



We have also arranged a special stop at **La Sorgente Agriturismo** where they will demonstrate how they make fresh Mozzarella, and of course allow us to taste.



Tuesday, September 30 and Saturday, October 11 The Isle of Capri




Board the fast ferry to the **Isle of Capri** which has served as a resort since the Roman Republic, and features the Marina Piccola (the little harbour), the Belvedere of Tragara (a high panoramic promenade lined with villas), the limestone crags called sea stacks that project above the sea (the faraglioni), and the town of Anacapri featuring spectacular views from high above the harbor. Our guide will show us the highlights and we are also hopeful to arrange a tour around the island by boat. Following our tour, there will be free time for lunch and/or shopping before we return to the hotel for dinner.



Wednesday, October 1 and Sunday, October 12

Tour of **Pompeii**




In the morning, we travel to **Pompeii** for a 2.5 hour guided tour of the fascinating ruins of Pompeii, buried by 20 feet of volcanic ash and pumice from the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD.



After our tour of Pompeii, we travel to our hotel in Tuscany – **Relais Cortefreda** – where we will enjoy dinner and spend the next 3 days/nights of our tour.



Thursday, October 2 and Monday, October 13 Tour of **Florence**



In the morning we will be treated to a 3 hour guided tour of Florence – "Cradle of the Renaissance" – featuring the palaces, squares, churches and old bridge.



Our tour will include a visit to **The Duomo** and the gold paradise doors of the Baptistry before we continue to **Piazza della Signoria** to see the many statues and fountains.



Our tour will conclude at **Ponte Vecchio** (Old Bridge) after which you will have time for lunch (on your own) and shopping, with the afternoon free to further explore Florence.



For those who simply must see Michelangelo's original statue of David, our guide can arrange a visit to the **Academy of Fine Arts** (additional cost) during your free time in the afternoon.





Friday, October 3 and Tuesday, October 14 Tour of **Siena** and **San Gimignano**

and Wine Tasting



Today we visit **Siena**, one of Italy's loveliest medieval cities and featured in James Bond's Quantum of Solace.







We will experience the traditional heart of Siena's town life with our tour of **San Domenico**, Piazza Salimbeni, Palazzo Piccolomini and Piazza del Campo, including entrance to the spectacular Duomo (Cathedral).



Then it's off to **San Gimignano** for further touring and free time for lunch (on our own). This medieval hilltop town in central Italy is a must-see destination for anyone interested in history, culture, and beautiful landscapes






Saturday, October 4 and Wednesday, October 15 Tour of **Orvieto** on our way to **Rome**




According to Rick Steves "Orvieto is one of the most striking, memorable, and enjoyable hill towns in central Italy. A visit here will reward you with a delightful, perfectly preserved, and virtually traffic-free world highlighted by a colorful-inside-and-out cathedral and some of Italy's best wine."




We will take the **funicular** up to the town where our local guide will meet us for a 2-hour city tour to see the sights and including entrance to **Orvieto Basilica**, followed by **lunch** in a



In the afternoon, we will continue to **Rome** to check-in at **A.Roma Lifestyle hotel** and enjoy dinner at the hotel. A.Roma will be our home base for our final 3 days/nights in Italy.



Sunday, October 5 and Thursday, October 16 Tour of **Ancient Rome** and **Monumental Rome**



This morning we meet our local guide for a 3-hour tour of **Ancient Rome**, including the Capitoline Hill, the Tarpeian Rock, and the Roman Forum with the House of the Vestal Virgins and the Basilica of Constantine, as well as the Colosseum from the outside.







Optional Morning Tour (additional cost – about 18 Euros pp) - for those who MUST see the inside of the Colosseum, our guide can arrange entrance if you prefer to tour the Colosseum instead of our tour of Ancient Rome in the morning.



After lunch (on our own), our tour continues in the historical center of Rome including the **Trevi Fountain**, **Pantheon**, **Piazza Navona** and **Piazza di Spagna** (Spanish Steps), among other sites.



Monday, October 6 and Friday, October 17 Tour of **Vatican City**



Today we will we be treated to a guided tour of **Vatican City**, including St. Peter's Square, St. Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel with the "Pieta" by Michelangelo and breathtaking interior work by Bernini.



Enjoy some free time before and after our tour of **Vatican City**, for shopping, relaxing and lunch (on our own) before our Gala Farewell Dinner.
